SOAP DEVOTIONS & JOURNALING

At OurChurch doing regular devotions and journaling is a value. It is a discipline that we need to practice regularly if we desire to grow in our relationship with God. Here are some tips on how to get started with SOAP Devotions and journaling.

The first step is to purchase yourself a book where you can journal what God is saying to you regularly. A small spiral bound book from the supermarket works wonders! Or you can purchase a Life Journal from your local campus.

HOW CAN IT HELP YOU?

LISTEN: “I will teach you and instruct you in the way that you should go...”

Psalms 32:8

God is speaking and He wants to walk daily with you! This Life Journal will help you to capture and catalogue the lessons He teaches in a way that will help you to grow!

INQUIRE: “You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all of your heart”

Jeremiah 29:13

God wants us to seek Him with all of our hearts, and when we do, He meets us right where we are. This journal will encourage and remind you daily that He waits for you.

FAITH: “Discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness” 1 Tim. 4:7

Our faith will grow as we get to know Him more. This journal will help add the substance of faith to your life.

EXPERIENCE: “If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them” John. 13:17

It is not just knowing things that builds our faith.

It is doing them! It is applying the lessons God is teaching us that brings a blessing.

HOW TO DO IT

STEP 1:

Find the Bible reading corresponding to today's date from the Bible reading program. Turn to the chapter in your Bible, asking the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you. Mark off each daily reading to keep yourself accountable.

STEP 2:

Read the passages. As you are reading, underline anything the Lord impresses to your life as a personal word to be applied. When you read with an open heart, the Lord will give you words of encouragement, direction and correction. (2 Tim. 3:16)

STEP 3:

When God has revealed a special lesson of life to you, turn to a fresh page in your journal to record what God has just shown you.

- Enter the date.
- Title the page.
- Record a topic that would generally describe the lesson.
- Enter what God has revealed to you.
- Give application as to how you will be different today because of what you have just read.
- Record a prayer (see example on next page).

STEP 4:

Turn to the Table of Contents in the front of your Life Journal and catalogue your entry by date, topic, title and page. (See example on next page)

STEP 5:

Conclude your devotional time by praying about the things you have just written, and by asking God to help you apply them to your life. If it is significant add it to your prayer list and intercede for it and the other items you have placed there previously.

Memorising God's word enables us to become more and more like Jesus. It renews our hearts and transforms our minds. As we speak the Word, our minds intuitively become like the mind of Christ.

REMEMBER

This Life Journal is designed to serve you in your growth with Jesus. You can be flexible in how you use it, but be sure to develop a healthy habit of spending time daily with the Lord.

Some have asked “When is the best time for my devotions? In the morning or in the evening?”

My answer to that is, “The best time is when you are at your best!”
If you’re a morning person, do your devotions in the morning.
If you are an evening person, do your devotions at night.
The bottom line is: “Jesus deserves your best, so give Him the best part of your day!”

When reading the bible it is important to remember that it is primarily written around two major covenants. One covenant for the nation of Israel, and the other covenant for ALL the nations of the world.

Moses - (Old Covenant) = Genesis - Malachi (Hebrew Bible or Text)
“this is the backstory to the greatest story”

Jesus - (New Covenant) = Matthew - Revelation (Christian Bible or Text)
“this is the greatest story”

So let’s read the Old Covenant for Historical purposes, let’s glean Inspiration from seeing how God worked through certain individuals but let’s never apply it unless we see the same principle in operation on the other side of the cross in Jesus Christ.

SOAP has been carefully put together by Ps Wayne Cordeiro to help us daily read the old covenant to Israel and then move straight into the new covenant in Jesus to reveal whether this same principle continues on the other side of the cross, or how it has evolved under the new covenant of grace and truth.

Yes, the bible is ALL Inspired, yes, it’s ALL Authoritative, but it’s just NOT ALL Applicable to ALL People.

So let’s be informed and inspired by the backstory, but let’s only apply from the greatest story “The Gospel of Jesus Christ” in the New Covenant to our lives.

All Scripture is equally inspired.
All Scripture is not equally important.
All Scripture is not equally applicable.
